Adirondack rentals are available in any one of several regions within the Park and in all shapes and sizes, depending on your needs. Due to the popularity of the region, you should reserve your Adirondack rental several months in advance, but there are usually last minute vacancies to choose from if you make a spur of the moment decision to visit the area. There are log cabins, summer camps, chalets, bed and breakfasts and lake front cottages with lake rights available on a weekly or less than weekly basis. [Adirondack rentals](#) are meant to enjoy all year round, not just summertime. If you love fall colors, why not take some time off to enjoy a quiet Adirondack autumn. And wintertime, well, it goes without saying that there is plenty to do in the Adirondacks in the winter. You could spoil yourself with a condominium in one of the many area ski resorts.

Since Adirondack rentals are available all year round, you have no reason not to take advantage of the many regional outdoor activities. In spring, summer and fall you can explore the many hiking and mountain biking trails, equestrian camps, lakes for boating, fishing and swimming and rushing rivers and streams that are ideal for white water rafting.
