You have several top shelf practices to choose from if you are looking for a dentist in Greenville, SC. Dentists in Greenville, SC are committed to patient education and compassionate care courtesy of state of the art dental equipment and a dedication to continued education in the latest developments in dental medicine.

Greenville, SC dentists emphasize good, comprehensive dental care for the whole family. In fact, young parents are encouraged to bring their babies in as soon as the age of six months for a first dental checkup. It is never too soon to start on a lifetime of good dental habits.

For your first visit, your Greenville, SC dentist and staff will give you a thorough dental cleaning with fluoride treatment, plaque and tartar removal, xrays to check for early decay, tumors, bone loss or other tooth and gum issues, and a visual examination of the mouth, tongue, throat and gums for evidence of oral cancer or periodontal disease. If needed, your Greenville, SC dentist will consult with you on a plan of action should your visit uncover any issues.

Greenville, SC dentists perform cosmetic and restorative services in addition to general family dental care. Cosmetic services generally range from the application of porcelain crowns to strengthen and protect damaged teeth to bridges, veneers and teeth whitenings that bring the sparkle back to your smile. Veneers are thin coverings made of porcelain that are bonded to the front of your teeth to cover unsightly cracks and gaps. These durable dental appliances are designed to last for years and can, in many cases, eliminate the need for crowns or braces.

Greenville, SC dentists also provide restorative procedures such as composite fillings, dentures and bridges. Composite (tooth colored) fillings restore decayed, cracked or fractured teeth. Dentures are removable appliances designed to closely match your smile as they replace missing teeth and surrounding tissue. Complete dentures replace an entire arch of missing teeth; partial dentures replace several teeth missing from within the same arch and keep the remaining teeth from shifting position.

Your Greenville, SC dentist will include a periodontal exam as part of your regular dental checkups. Periodontal probes are used to ascertain the presence and severity of gingivitis, periodontitis and advanced periodontitis. A couple of periodontal cleanings are all that is required if the disease is caught in the early stages. If the disease is more advanced, scaling and root planing will be necessary.
